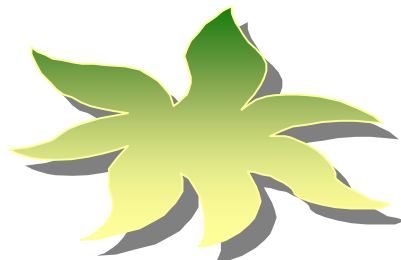
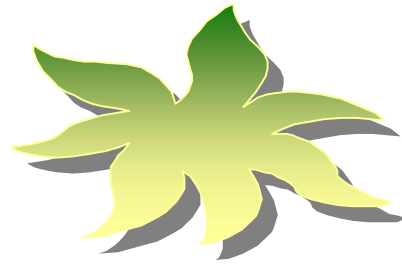

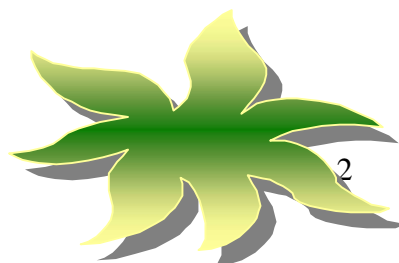

Founder's Message:-

Credibility and the impact it makes on any programme or movement, to bring about change and transformation, is time consuming. It is believed that in "EDUCATION" it takes inter generational processes to achieve a positive impact. First, have a definite, clear practical idea; a goal, an objective. Second, have the necessary means to achieve your ends; wisdom, money, materials, and methods. Third, adjust all your means to that end. India is full of poor street children. We need to support as many as possible. There is a lot to be done in this field to eradicate the literacy level of Indian children. These underprivileged children are not able to study for want of money and proper guidance.

We help children to recognise and express their individual interests and abilities. We instill in them a sense of belonging and support them in realising their dreams. We also ensure that children receive education and necessary skills training to be successful and contributing members of society. We help them to find their path and shape their own futures.

We now have strength of more than 125 girl children and 20 girls are being supported from outside. These 20 girls are taught only when they come to attend classes. All these children belong to underprivileged family. The main aim of our foundation is to bring them to the main stream like others. Out of these One hundred and twenty five girls around 50 are studying in Secondary / Sr. Secondary level education from "National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), NOIDA. Five to Six subjects are being taught to them daily by two different teachers. These children are being taught for more than 335 days in a year on regular basis. Around 55 or more children are carrying out several studies such as learning Basics of Computer, English Speaking and Mathematics up to Secondary School Level of CBSE Board.

So far all around 30 students of "Aakash Maindwal Foundation" have passed Secondary school examination. All 30 students have been admitted in Sr. Secondary Course from NIOS. No family member in their entire family had studied up to class 10th. These children did rigorous study of 8 to 10 hours daily. All the Sr. secondary students of October batch 2016 have passed with flying colours. Most of them have joined call centre and some of them have joined as a sales girl in a branded shop outlet before taking admission in Delhi University in June 2017. Whereas from April 2016 Batch AMF girls took the admission in Delhi University as regular basis and few had taken admission in SOL under Delhi University for further studies. Foundation is bound to help them in continuing their studies. Twenty girls of our foundation have also taken admission in Graduation from Delhi University / IGNOU as well plus some of them are doing graduation from other universities.

President's Message:

Aakash Maindwal Foundation (AMF) since its formation (03/09/2009) has been directly dedicated to fighting poverty and social injustice through Education. We place special emphasis on investing in women and girls because our Six years of experience shows that their empowerment benefits whole communities.

We would like every girl to have an education, to be healthy and safe, to have skills, have the ability to exercise choice. And one of the keys to creating these opportunities for girls is to build knowledge for the sector, raise more funds, and forge collaborations across donors, non-profits, governments. Adolescent girls are discriminated against twice over: by gender and by age – programs are largely aimed either at children or at women, leaving adolescent girls in the gap.

However, adolescent girls can become successful agents of change. When they are empowered, educated and kept healthy, a range of issues such as maternal mortality, child survival and gender-based violence can be resolved, and the cycle of poverty broken.

To bring the positive change AMF have been unwavering in mission to assist and support the poor and destitute and our track records not only establishes its credibility but also has sown the seeds of change and impact. Aakash Maindwal Foundation is extremely happy for this performance and hopes to continue in the same spirit for years to come, bringing solace and prosperity to vulnerable.

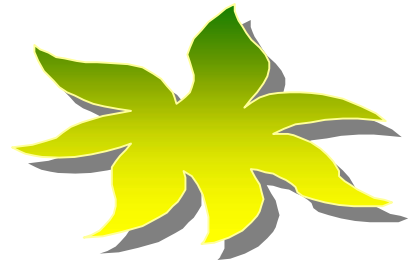

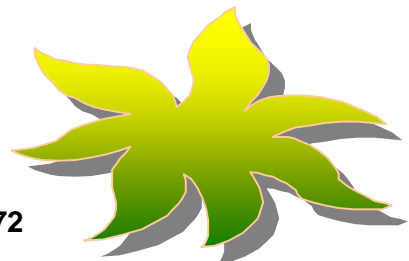

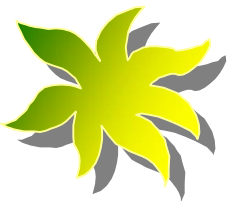

A Small Brief

“Aakash Maindwal Foundation” since its formation (03/09/2009) has been keenly interested in educating the underprivileged girl children. AMF believes that the desired changes in the lives of such children will come only when more and more privileged people will join this movement. The Foundation also believes that the only way to ensure a better future for these children is by educating them. That’s why Aakash Maindwal Foundation’ (AMF) is encouraging dropouts to continue their studies through National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS).

The foundation initially started by teaching the girl children from the house. These underprivileged girl children’s were then taught in the Ground Floor of the Apartment at the Correspondence address. Due to increase in the number of children the foundation entered into a new venture on 8th July 2012 by taking a rented accommodation and opening an institute called “TAMANNA” at 165-A, Kamana, Sector –V, Vaishali, Ghaziabad. The number of children kept on increasing and the foundation took a two room rented accommodation in Sector–5, Kalpana, Vaishali, GHAZIABAD. After 5/21, Kalpna Apartments, Sector–5 new address of “Tamanna” is now “Aakash Maindwal Foundation 71, Kalpana Apartments, Sector–5, Vaishali, GHAZIABAD.

We have aim to provide basic Secondary (10th) and Senior Secondary (12th) School Education to as many children’s as possible in the cluster of Vaishali, Ghaziabad. “AAKASH MAINDWAL FOUNDATION” has taken an initiative in ensuring admission of the following underprivileged children in National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), A 24/25 Institutional Area, Sector – 62, NOIDA in Class 10th (Secondary Schooling) and Class 12th (Sr. Secondary Schooling). Congratulations!! All the October batch AMF girls did extremely well in their Exams...Proud of them. The result of Sr. Secondary & Secondary school examination of NIOS (Nation Institute of open Schooling, Noida) for the April Batch was declared on 9th and 14th December respectively. In Sr. secondary Nancy has scored the highest marks followed by Lata. They really proved that no one can stop them in achieving their goal as they all believe in that THEY CAN DO IT...Congratulations!! to all the students of AMF who passed their Secondary school examination and Sr. Secondary (CBSE, UP & NIOS) board Exams with flying colours. Sr Secondary NIOS (2015-17) April Batch students cleared their four papers and only one paper is left to clear as in NIOS student has to clear their paper within two years to get the sr. secondary certificate. They had completed their 75% of sr. secondary Exams with flying colours as more than half way they all have crossed to achieve the destination. Congrats & Keep it up.....God Bless!!

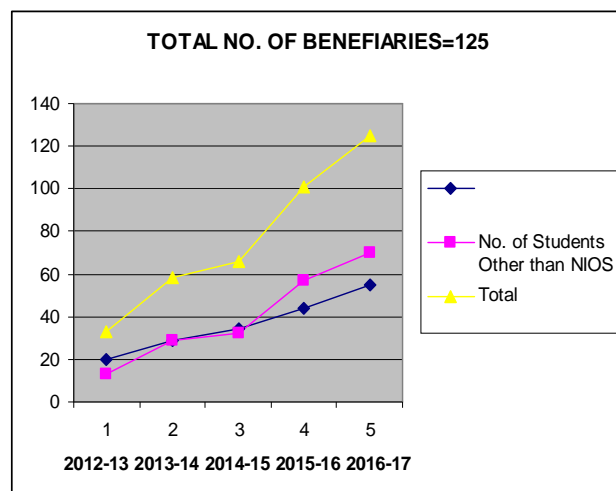
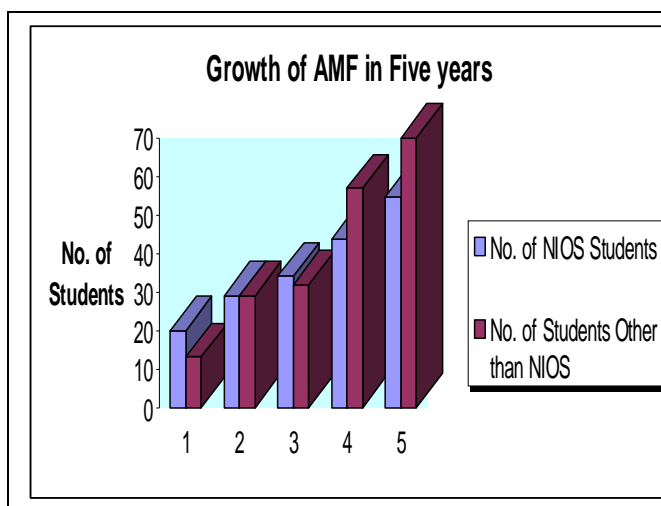

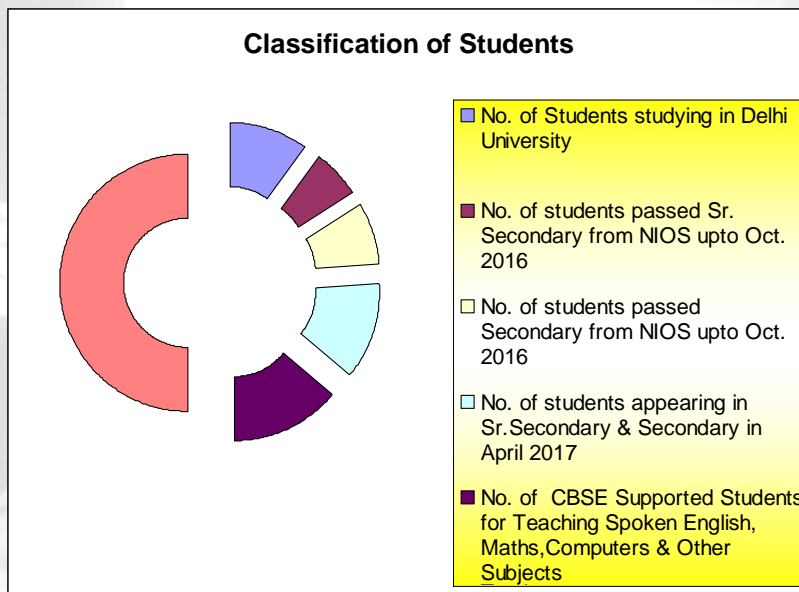
